

**What to do in Portland on Monday, Feb 12, 2018

All Day	Eat out at any of the restaurants along Broadway or Weidler— just a few blocks north of DoubleTree. Also, check out <a href="#">Restaurant Guide</a> .
	Shop at the huge <a href="#">Lloyd Center Mall</a> across the street and just north of DoubleTree, have some coffee and sit and watch the ice skaters.
	<b>Visit</b> any of the <a href="#">12 Top-Rated Tourists Attractions in Portland</a> .
	<b>Ride the <a href="#">Max Light Rail</a> to <a href="#">Pioneer Square</a></b> in downtown Portland and shop, eat, and people watch. (Max station is located across the south east corner from DoubleTree and ride takes only 15-20 minutes.)
	<b>Go for a bike ride.</b> Portland is extremely bike friendly and has loaner bikes available from stations all over town—one located right in front of the DoubleTree hotel. For info, go to <a href="http://www.biketownpdx.com">www.biketownpdx.com</a>

2:30-4:00p	<b>Attend the free Guided Practica</b> in the Cascade Ballroom (upstairs of the DoubleTree) with festival instructors there to help.
After 2:00p	<b>See a movie</b> at the <a href="#">Regal Lloyd 10 Theater Cinema</a> , 1510 N.E. Multnomah St (3 blocks east of the DoubleTree)
8:00p-1:00a	<b>Attend the Monday Closing Milonga</b> in the Cascade Ballroom (upstairs of the DoubleTree). Admission is \$10.
8:00p-1:00a	<b>Attend Milonga de Oro</b> at the Polish Center, 3832 N Interstate Ave. Admission is \$10.
